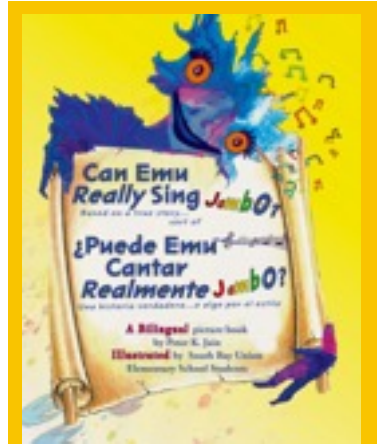


A SequoiaSong Activity
